Minutes of the Technical Commission for the Competitions Mantua 19th – 20th September 2008

On 19th, 20th and 21st September 2008, a meeting of AESOR Technical Commission was held, to clarify some points of the games regulation.

The Technical Delegates of the following nations were present: Austria, Belgium, Canada, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands, Poland, Spain and Switzerland.

Topics discussed:

- 1. Use of hobnail shoes during the orienteering competition.
- 2. The order of identification of stations during the orienteering competition.

Development and conclusions of the debate:

1. The use hobnailed or clipped shoe is forbidden.

This ruled can be revised by the country which organizes the event. The decision must be communicated one year before the start of the competitions or it will not be taken into consideration.

During the following competitions (Viterbo – June 2009) the prohibition is valid.

Decision approved after voting: 10 for and 2 against.

2. The stations of the orienteering competitions must be identified in an increasing order, not casually; otherwise, the participant is disqualified.

Decision approved after voting: 11 for and 1 against.

Agenda of AESOR Central Committee Viterbo 17th, 18th and 19th April 2009:

- 1. Throwing of the grenade: with the same score, time could be considered.
- **2.** Obstacle route: eventual elimination of some passages for the female team.
- 3. Rowing boat competition: time will be counted from the moment the boat is put into water.
